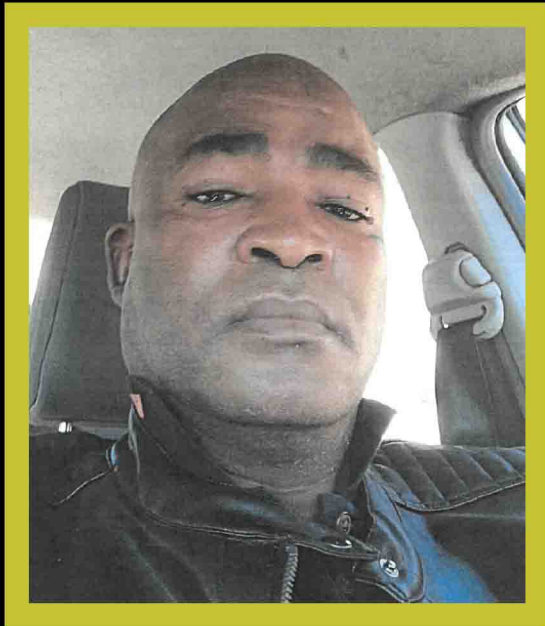

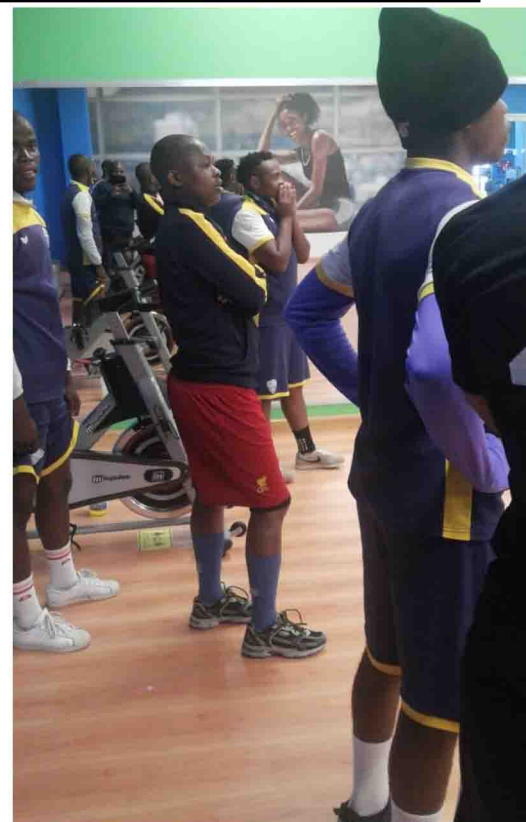
Police FC ready for ABCML

THE HISTORY OF SAFA OVERBERG

SAFA is the largest membership structure in the Country, with approximately 3 million active footballers, over 10 000 clubs, 40 000 football teams. Football is played in thousands of schools in our country. In its 9 provinces there are 52 Regions with 341 LFAs. And at the point of the Western Cape, is the SAFA Overberg Region located.

SAFA Overberg is one of 6 Regions in the Western Cape. The others, whom we compete against in Provincial playoffs, are SAFA Eden, SAFA Cape Town, SAFA Cape Winelands, SAFA Central Karoo and SAFA West Coast.

Our Regional Presidents

In 2006, SAFA Overberg elected its first structure, where Mr Eddie Petersen from Villiersdorp in the Theewaterskloof LFA was elected the first Regional President. Due to his lack of football background and experience, he was soon replaced by Mr Songezo Tshandu, the Vice President elect. He was from Hermanus LFA. This occurred in early 2007.

The rocky start continued when Mr Tshandu was suspended at the Annual Regional General Council meeting due to his failure to develop the Region. The Region stayed far behind the other new Regions and in so doing could not measure up in any shape or form. In that meeting it was decided to elect Gansbaai LFA member, Mr Siphon Miya as the President.

At the next Elective Annual General Meeting, Mr Miya was outvoted and replaced by Mr Morris Tshabalala from as Regional President. He remained President for 4 years and was the first to fully complete a term as such.

He was then outvoted by the incumbent President, Mr Tankiso Modipa. The feeling of the clubs was that Mr Tshabalala only developed within his Overtstrand Region and neglected the other LFAs. He has since been re-elected for a second term.

Our LFAs

The Region is divided into 6 Local Football Associations, Namely, Theewaterskloof LFA; Kleinmond LFA; Hermanus LFA; Gansbaai LFA; Swellendam LFA and Cape Agulhas LFA.

In 2017, a League Co-ordinator was appointed to assist in the development and running of the Regional Leagues in SAFA Overberg.

In 2018, the Regional Premier Division was established as a mirror development League for the SAB League. This was to bridge the gap from LFA to SAB and develop a strength vs strength culture in its football.

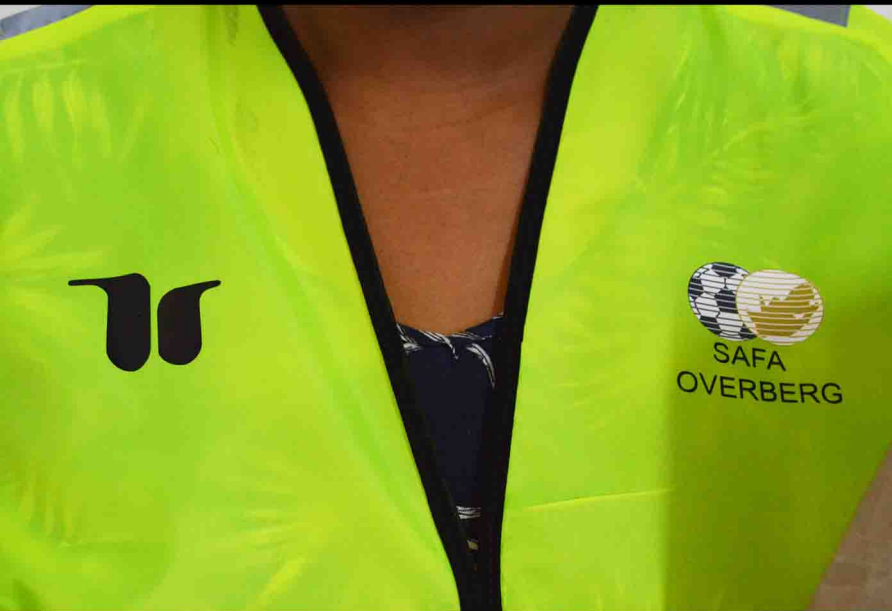

The lowest points it was when we played in Premier Division for the first time. It was very tough for us, because it was a first time to play with teams from different places. We were used to playing in Kleinmond.

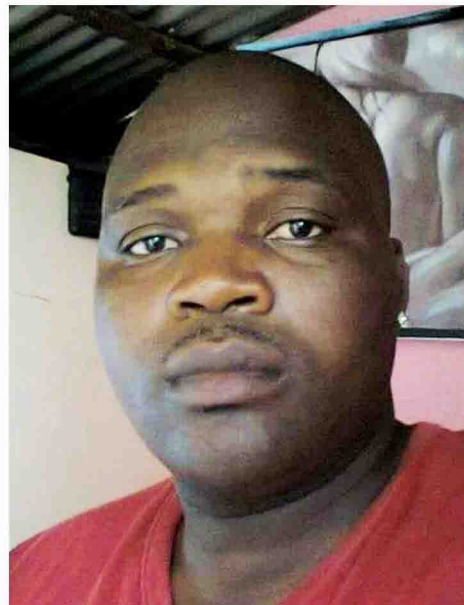
5.) What are your club's colours? – Green and white

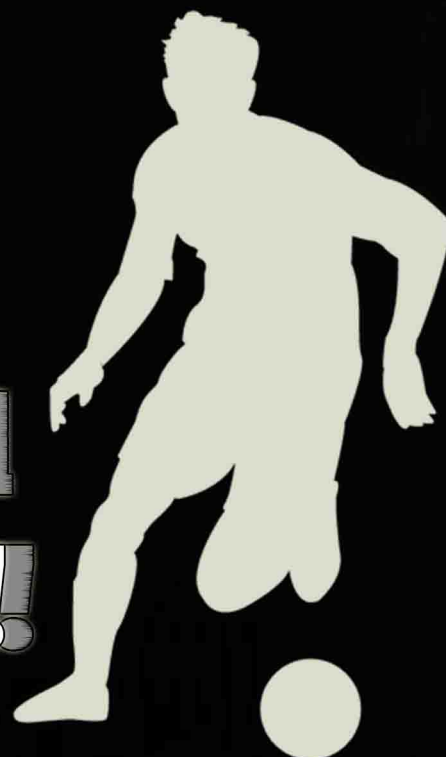

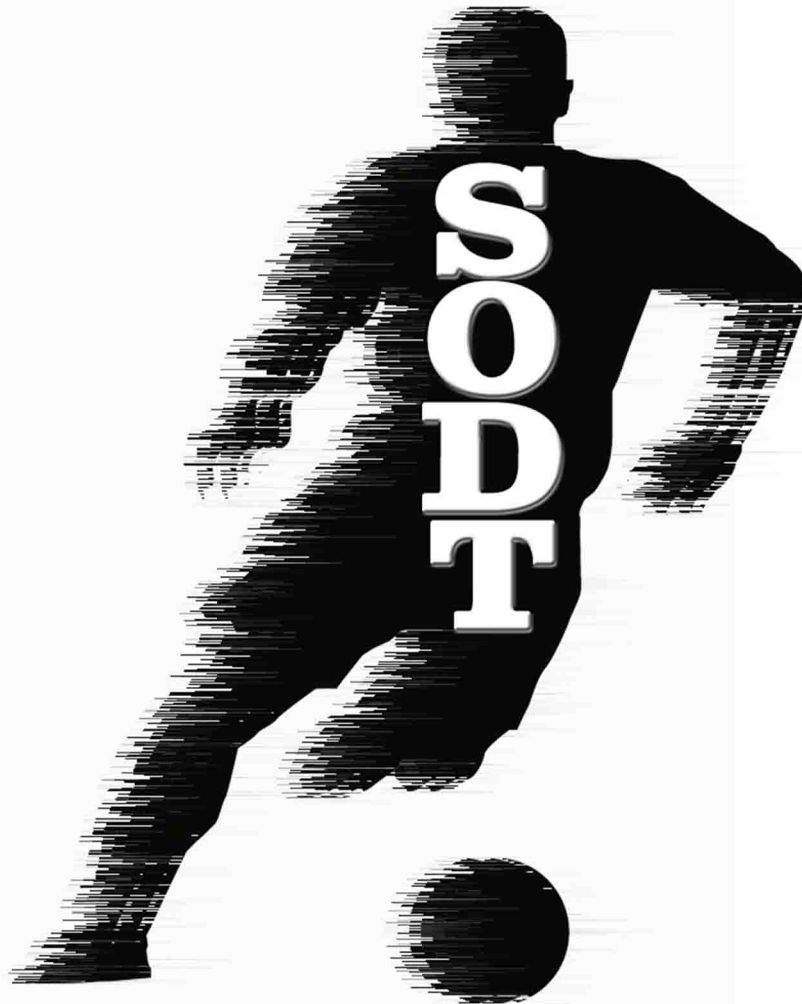

1.) Where and when did your club start? (Origins)

The club was formed in Bredasdorp in year of June 2015.

2.) Any early memories of those days that still stand out for you?

The early stages of forming the team was not easy for us, we struggled to get players during those times. I remember in 2016 when we first joined the LFA, we played with 7 players against Swallows FC we managed to win 4-3, our players were very few and most of them were at work.

3.) What has been your Club's highlight, biggest achievement?

The club's biggest achievement was to qualify for Regional Premier League and qualifying for SAB league is beyond our comprehension.

4.) What was the lowest point?

The 2017\2018 season the club finished at Number 14 on the log standing and that was the last time the team got the lowest points.

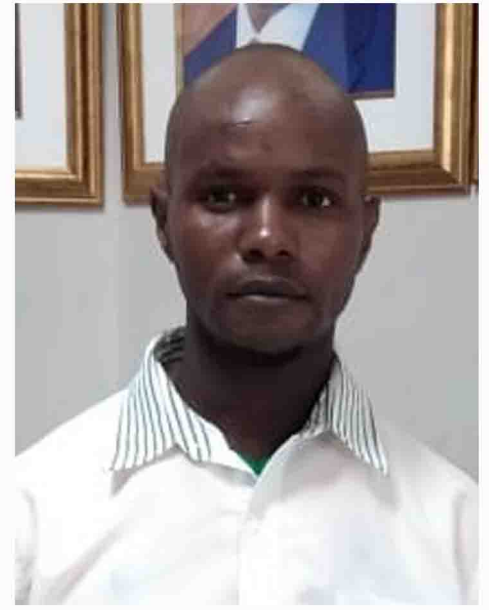
The club technical team is responsible for both programs, we are planning in introducing lady's soccer as well but due to lack of interested personnel the program is running slow.

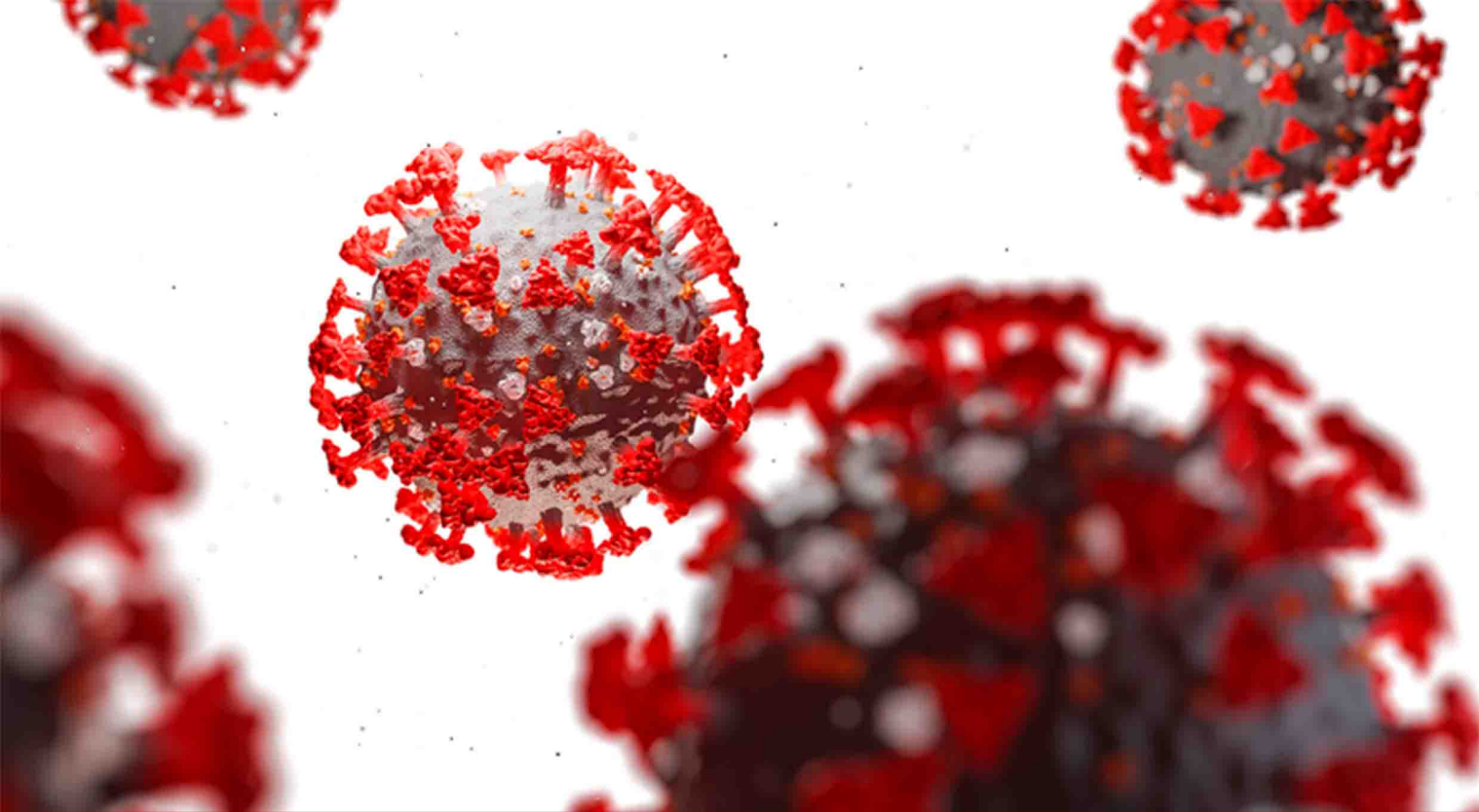
